

Pet Policy

We are glad you and your pet chose to stay with us.

In consideration of all Inn guests we ask that you follow the below policies.

Pets must **never** be left in rooms when owners are not in the building. They can be left in rooms while owners are eating meals in our dining room as long as we know where to find owners at all times in case there is a problem.

Pets are **not** to be in the library, lobby, or hallways except when walking directly between front door and room.

Pets are allowed on the front porch, only in the area to the right when exiting the building. This area keeps people that are arriving from the parking lot from walking past you and your pet.

Examples of behaviors considered unacceptable –
Barking excessively when in room or on front porch
Barking at guests
Dogs off leash
Dog jumping on guests

Thank you for your cooperation, some guests are uncomfortable around them, and even the best-behaved pets can occasionally be upset by something unexpected.

Pets **MUST** always be leashed while on property and not in your room.
